Locating the Community Safety Plan and the Way Forward

The Community Safety Plan requires a location that will ensure that selected projects arising out of the action plan for Cederberg Municipality are implemented. It also requires being a part of local government policies and priorities so that it is sustainable. In this regard, the safety plan should be incorporated into the Cederberg Municipality Integrated Development Plan (IDP). The Community Service Department within the Municipality should be the drivers of this process as the plan is a cross cutting developmental strategy.

The action plan should ideally examine and evaluate existing interventions in the community and address any shortcomings. The projects should then be scaled to an appropriate level. Adequate resources should then be allocated to each project with timeframes to ensure timeous delivery. Continuous monitoring of projects must be undertaken bi-annually by an oversight committee.

Ultimately, commitment and dedication of government officials and those with political authority can ensure the safety plan is a success. "The different government departments need to commit and communicate with each other, and integrate their respective programmes addressing unemployment, poverty etc"

The Municipality should commit to the Community Safety Forum and its processes and programmes, including the Safety Plan and also the need to ensure that the Plan is addressed within Municipality's Budget
