Tenders are hereby invited for the abovementioned services.

It is estimated that bidders should have a **CIDB grading of 3CE or higher and should provide valid proof thereof. Bidders will have to be registered in the applicable class of registration.**

The closing date and time of the tender is on **15 June 2023 at 12H00** and tenders will be opened in public immediately thereafter in the Supply Chain Management Committee Room, Clanwilliam Administration.

Bids will be evaluated according to the 80/20 preference points system. The tender is subject to the Council Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022.

Tenders must be valid and binding for one hundred and twenty **(120) days** after closing date.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender, and/or to re-advertise or reject any tender, or to accept a part of it. The Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest or highest or any tender.
